Check your equipment before use



Only authorized persons may use the equipment



Make sure the correct driving position is selected



Be aware of your work environment to prevent damage



Be prepared to react to any unexpected situation



Keep a safe distance when approaching hazardous areas



No passengers



Check the stability of your load before moving



The elevation of persons is only permitted with suitable and certified platforms



Never walk under a raised load



Respect the maximum capacity indicated on the load chart



Use appropriate accessories according to the load requirement



Adapt your driving direction to suit your visibility



Always check the load capacity of bays, docks, gateways...



when you use your equipment the safety belts are mandatory



Be aware of load Gradeability



When parking respect safety rules



Make sure the load is stable and positioned against the forks



Be aware of objects, fabrics ... which can get caught in the machine.



Never make unauthorized modifications to your equipment



Periodic maintenance must comply with legal requirements



Be aware of the legal safety requirements and comply



Read the instructions in the operator's manual



Be careful when refueling



Never store your LPG forklift in a confined space. Turn off the gas after
